COVID Safety Statement

The Circles of Life Planning Committee is committed to hosting a safe event for all conference participants in 2022. Preventive measures are evolving and may be updated as the conference approaches. Our decisions and preventive measures are guided by the requirements and guidance of the U.S. Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and federal, state, and local health authorities.

Preventive measures taken at the conference will include:

- **Masks will be required for all sessions and event activities¹.** (Exceptions will be made for those unable to wear a mask due to disability or medical condition.)
- Social Distancing (fewer people seated at tables, more space during sessions)
- Hand sanitizing stations
- Low contact registration process
- Enhanced sanitation of meeting and exhibit spaces

The responsibility for a safe event environment is shared by each conference attendee. All registrants are expected to adhere to and abide by the preventative measures. To play your part, you should not attend the Circles of Life Conference if you:

- Are experiencing, or within 10 days prior to the event, have experienced any signs or symptoms of COVID-19
- Have been exposed to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19
- Have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and have not yet completed your quarantine.

Vaccination: While we STRONGLY encourage all participants to be fully vaccinated prior to attending the conference, we will not be requesting proof of vaccination in order to attend the conference.

¹. *Masks will be required in all meeting rooms, in hallways, and during plenary sessions. Additional masks will be available from the conference. We encourage KN-95 or N-95 masks and not cloth masks. Masks will NOT be required in your hotel room or outdoors.*
